ENT Services Planned for Ontario

GALION – Galion Community Hospital will welcome Eric R. Grimes, M.D. to their physician team on July 6. Specializing in Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT) surgery and Board certified in otolaryngology, Dr. Grimes presently serves patients at his Mansfield office who are from Ashland, Richland, Crawford, and Morrow counties and the surrounding area. Plans include a move to the Ontario location of 2981 W. 4th Street with no change of phone number. His current staff will accompany Dr. Grimes with his move. This includes audiologist Lynnette Roth, FAAA.

“Dr. Grimes would be an asset anywhere he chooses to go,” commented Jerry Morasko, President and CEO for the hospital. “With the shortage of ENT physicians in our area, we are twice-blessed to welcome such a fine physician. We have already witnessed his surgical skill here at GCH and look forward to seeing more of him. We have chosen to place him in our Ontario Medical Building because of its centralized location. It’ll be an easy drive for his patients by being between Mansfield and Galion, and also be a convenient distance from Galion Community Hospital where he will be performing his surgical procedures.”

Dr. Grimes plans to continue offering the full complement of in-office services he currently provides, including audiological testing and rehabilitation, allergy testing and treatment, endoscopic evaluation, and minor surgical procedures.

Dr Grimes performs the full spectrum of ear, nose, and throat surgical procedures. These include treatment for pediatric procedures of ear tubes, adenoidectomy, and tonsillectomy, as well as treatment of neck masses, cysts, and other childhood diseases of organs in the face and neck. Adult surgical procedures include those for the treatment nasal blockage and sinus infection, chronic ear infection, masses of of the salivary, thyroid, and parathyroid glands, disorders of voice and swallowing, treatment for sleep apnea and snoring, and the treatment of cancers in the head and neck region,

Earning his Bachelor of Science in Biology and graduating Magna Cum Laude from the Ohio State University in Columbus, Dr. Grimes also studied at the University of York in Heslington, England. He completed his medical degree at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine in Cleveland and his internship and residency at Temple University Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Originally from Ohio, Dr. Grimes and his wife, Sharon, live in the Mansfield area and are the parents of three boys.
